## Sign to tout progress toward Mount View Performing Arts Center project

THORNDIKE (Feb 1): A colorful campaign goal sign designed by a Newport business will soon be charting the fund-raising progress for the Mount View Performing Arts Center project.

FUTURE MSAD 3 received approval from the SAD 3 administration to erect a sign in front of the Mount View complex in Thorndike showing the progress toward the \$575,000 capital campaign goal.

The 4-foot by 8-foot wooden sign features the FUTURE MSAD 3 logo with the slogan, "Help us fill the house!"

Jim and Linda Miller of Miller Signs and Graphics in Newport designed the sign.

Volunteers dug the post holes and provided the posts to hold the sign, which will be installed in February in front of Mount View. Less than \$126,000 is needed to meet the Unity Foundation challenge grant and the overall campaign goal.
