FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How will I know where my named seat is located?

A: Named seats are located in all 14 rows based on six gift levels, from \$150 to \$2,500. Named seats are available on a first-come, first-served basis, and will be assigned to the appropriate row as gifts come in. A master list of named seats will be available upon request.

Q: If I have already given, can I apply my gift to my named seat?

A: Yes! If you made a direct contribution to FUTURE MSAD 3 you may apply that amount to your named seat. For example, if you contributed \$50, and want to name a \$150 seat, an additional \$100 gift will name your seat.

Q: If I played in the FUTURE MSAD 3 golf tournament does the money I paid apply to my named seat?

A: No. The fees for the golf tournament were greens fees and not contributions. If you made an additional direct gift to FUTURE MSAD 3 we will have a record of your contribution and will apply it to your seat if you choose.

We have waited so long...

With the new school comes a wonderful opportunity to build a **Performing Arts Center** at Mount View that will provide a high-caliber performance space for all of the district's students.

The **Performing Arts Center** will enhance the development of student theatre programs in the elementary, middle, and high school. It will enable our community members to host public events, community theatre productions, musicals, concerts and more!

Q: If I give \$500 will I be able to use the Unity Foundation match to name a \$1,000 seat?

A: No. Only your contributions are credited toward your seat/s. For example, to name a \$1,000 seat, your total contribution must be \$1,000.

Q: May I name more than one seat?

A: Of course! But remember that named seats are available for a limited time – so don't delay!

Q: When I attend an event will I be able to sit in my seat?

A: Being recognized on a seat is a naming gift opportunity only and does not in any way guarantee that the seat will be available for you to sit in during performances. Over the years thousands of people will see and appreciate your support.

Q: What will the name plate look like?

A: The architect has not selected the exact seats for the auditorium but we can tell you the plates will be 3"x 2" and will hold three lines of engraved text. Once the seats are selected, we'll be able to know what style and material the plates will be.

Q: Will my seat contribution be matched?

A: The Unity Foundation will match contributions up to \$250,000.

Q: Is my seat contribution tax-deductible?

A: Yes, all contributions to the campaign for the Mount View Performing Arts Center are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law.
